# Carmalt Jones Club

The Otago University Rowing Club, which has been in existence since 1929, has recently (2016) set up a Charitable Foundation to build a fund that will support the club in the future. The Foundation is now a legal entity and has been granted Charitable Status under the Charities Commission. It has 5 Trustees, one appointed by the University. The fund has 3 divisions

1. Carmalt Jones Club – Long term club support fund from OURC Alumni
2. Plant Fund – Funding for boats, oars, and other equipment
3. General Fund – Funding to support the other purposes of the foundation

As part of that Foundation you can now join the **Carmalt Jones Club**. There are three levels to choose from:-

Platinum \$5,000 (spread over 5 years)

Gold \$2,500 (spread over 5 years)

Silver \$1,000 (spread over 5 years)

The foundation is a registered charitable entity. Charity Number CC53304. The foundation has IRD donee status (IRD Number 119-863-910) and provides for individuals or companies to obtain a tax deduction for contributions to the foundation. Tax Receipts will be posted to you.
